



# Programs and Services

## ADULT PROGRAM

Must be 18 years old and class graduated

Program Hours:

8:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m. Mon.-Thurs.

and 8:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. on Friday. Our fee for this program is \$20 annually. The purpose of this program is to allow adults, that did not graduate with their class, the opportunity to earn a high school diploma.

## ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM

Must be a high school age student currently enrolled in one of our sponsoring districts. A counselor or administrator must recommend the student for placement before they can be reviewed for acceptance in this program. Our fee for this program is \$50 annually.

Students attending the Alternative school have mandatory attendance from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Monday – Friday.



Certified instructors enroll students in the courses they need to complete their high school diploma.

Students can earn credits for working through our Work Study program.

Internet courses are available for eligible students.

## SENIOR FOR CREDIT PROGRAM

Must be enrolled in one of our sponsoring districts.

Program Hours: Mon.-Thurs. 3:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. Our fee for this program is \$125.00 per 1/2 credit.

The purpose of this program is to allow high school students to make up failed courses in order to graduate with their high school class.

## SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Must be a high school student currently enrolled in one of our sponsoring districts. Summer School is held in June and July. Our fee for this program is \$125.00 per 1/2 credit.

## ELO PROGRAM (Extended Learning Opportunity)

This program is for students that have been suspended or expelled from one of our sponsoring districts. An administrator must recommend the student for placement before they can be reviewed for acceptance in this program. Attendance is mandatory in this program from 4:00 p.m. – 7:00 Monday – Thursday.
